Topics of the guideline	The Guideline defines the requirements for the design, construction and maintenance of all buildings, taking into account the specific needs of people with reduced mobility, including people with disabilities		
Description of the guideline	<p>The Guideline defines the requirements for the design, construction and maintenance of all buildings (the elements of the urban area and the buildings and equipment) to provide an accessible architectural environment for the entire population, taking into account the specific needs of people with reduced mobility, including people with disabilities. Requirements apply to carrying out the reconstruction, major renovation, overhaul, conversion, extension and upgrading of existing elements of the urban area and the buildings and facilities. These consider people with various disabilities and ensure compliance with specific mobility requirements including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- long distance,</li> <li>- an inclined surface,</li> <li>- with technical aids,</li> <li>- with the driver when crossing streets and climbing stairs,</li> <li>- standing, pressing buttons and grip,</li> <li>- providing a range of accessibility at eye level</li> </ul>
