Description of the guideline	<p>The project "Stations for everyone" aims at making 60 railway stations in Sweden more accessible. People with disabilities, children and older people will more easily get to the train.</p> <p>Examples of what will be done on a station to make it more accessible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • guidance routes on platforms for people with visual limitations • clearly marked safety zones on platforms • guidance routes and safety zones to and from platforms • adequate slopes on ramps • better lighting, both public and on signs • tactile warning, guidance and information signs • tactile area map and tactile track number plates • new benches and ramps • new wind and weather protection • improved handrails • improved marking of stairs • contrast markings on projecting surfaces and objects • usable keypads in lifts
