Topics of the guideline	The Guideline deals with improving the accessibility of work and public spaces, as well as public transports. It gives instruments to assess the urban accessibility and proposes to appoint, in cities with more of 50.000 citizens, a "disability manager" which is responsible for promoting and developing the local PRM policy.	
Description of the guideline	The Guideline consists of two sections. The first section describes the operative areas of accessibility and particularly: 1) how to plan educational and work places accessible for all; 2) how to design an urban alternative mobility; 3) how to improve the accessibility of services and information. The second section gives 27 practical samples of what is meant to be "accessible for all" design.
